SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR DEPENDENTS OF DEA MEMBERS



To be considered for this student scholarship, you must:

- 1. Be a child or dependent of a Downey Education Association (DEA) member.
- 2. Be planning to attend college or vocational school. You must carry at least 12 concurrent units or full time equivalent at any school you attend.
- 3. Prepare a brief resume. If you are a graduating high school senior, include information covering your ninth-grade year to the present. If you are a vocational or college student, you may include high school information but be sure to include the years since then to the present (see sample). The following areas should be included:
 - a. Academic achievement, awards, and honors.
 - b. Extracurricular activities (sports, clubs, organizations, and offices held).
 - c. Community and service organizations of which you are a part.
 - d. Work experience, talents, and hobbies (how you spend your spare time).
- 4. Write an essay entitled, "My Future Plans and Expectations."
 - a. The essay will help the committee to select a person with sincere determination and ability to benefit from a continuing education.
 - b. The essay must reflect your own work. Applying standard English conventions is **HIGHLY** recommended.
 - c. The essay must be 250 words or less
- 5. Complete the DEA Dependent Scholarship Application, as <u>no other application</u> <u>form will be accepted.</u> If the application passes the paper screening process, you will be notified to schedule an interview with the Scholarship Committee. Interviews can be in person or online.
