 - a. The essay will help the committee to select a person with sincere determination and ability to benefit from a continuing education.
 - b. The essay must reflect your own work. Applying standard English conventions is **HIGHLY** recommended.
 - c. The essay must be 250 words or less
- 5. Complete the DEA Adult School Scholarship Application, as **no other application form will be accepted.**
